Unfinished Business

A proposal was made (and seconded): Add guideline verbiage that "OTW has the autonomy to discuss/vote on removal of a group that is in direct violation of a tradition or a concept from the website and meeting lists. Tradition/Concept must be cited directly". This is a guideline change and needs to go back to the groups for discussion/vote.

It was confirmed that similar guideline verbiage already exists in **Article III, 1. Participants, c),** which states "If an N.A. group or meeting is determined to be in violation of our Traditions and/or affecting N.A. as a whole, they will be asked to correct such behavior. If they choose not to, they will be removed from OTW meeting lists". This is now a closed issue that requires no further discussion.

New Business & Written Proposals

Proposal #1 was made by Dave A to add to OTW guidelines that RCM (or appointee) provide a GSR training each February and August for new GSR's and anyone else who wishes to attend. This would be added to Article V, Section 8, point F. This is a guideline change and needs to go back to groups to discuss/vote.
